



BP Sunbury work experience programme 2018/19

Thank you for your interest in work experience at BP Sunbury during the 2018/19 academic year. We offer one week unpaid placements and priority is given to students who attend our link schools/local to our office, but we welcome applications from all students in years 10–13 studying in the UK. Please click on the link below to access the Expression of Interest form, which should be completed as fully as possible as it will be sent to potential host managers.

Before completing the form, we encourage all applicants to take a look at our website www.bp.com for further information about our activities. They should also look at <https://www.startprofile.com> (registration required) where they will find information about careers within BP. All applicants to take the time to look at Start to identify the sort of career or work that they may be considering for the future. For example, requests for experience in '*Exploration and Production*' are less likely to be viewed favourably by potential managers as this covers a huge range of employment opportunities and we ask that applicants try to be more specific with areas such as '*Geology*' or '*Finance*'.

Placements are offered across a number of disciplines covering Upstream, Downstream and Functions. The number of placements vary each year and is dependent upon the number of colleagues we recruit each year to host students in the summer. The placements offer a chance to explore the world of work and take part in a small project related to the discipline students are placed in.

When completing the form think very carefully about the date you request a placement for as we not able to change this if you are successful in being placed. **All of our placements take place across the months of June, July and August.**

Please note, although BP has an alternative energy portfolio much of this business is based away from the BP Sunbury and we are therefore unable to offer work experience in this area, forms that request alternative energy only placements will automatically be discarded.

Demand for work experience placements at the ICBT is extremely high and completion of an Expression of Interest form does not guarantee a placement.

Applications for placements for the 2018/2019 academic year will close on **31 December 2018**, with all applicants being informed whether they have been successful by the **end of March 2019**. Late applications will not be accepted.
