[Minimum wage rise starts this month](#)

The minimum wage increases this month. The new rates are:

Apprentice Rate	£4.81	£4.30	11.9%
Accommodation Offset	£8.70	£8.36	4.1%

[Marks and Spencer](#) are to raise their minimum pay for staff to £10 an hour to match other retailers such as Aldi, Lidl, Morrisons and Sainsburys. Those working in a London M and S store will get £11.25 an hour.

MBDA, a global missile manufacturer is, according to a report in Business Live, planning to recruit hundreds of people across its UK operations this year. Government initiatives to level up employment opportunities for women

The government has announced [two new initiatives](#) to level up employment opportunities for women:

- Participating employers will run pilots aimed at closing salary gaps by publishing salaries on all job adverts
- New 'returners' programme to support women into STEM roles after taking time out to care for loved ones

The South West's growing tech sector

Falmouth Packet report on a new study from Whitecap Consulting which reveals that the South West's tech sector is set to grow by nearly £20bn, creating 125,000 new jobs by 2026. The article also reports that of the 12 major regions in the UK the South West has the fifth largest tech sector, with job creation due to rise by an additional 126,212 by 2026.

The UK film industry

A new report on the UK film industry suggests that 40,000 jobs need to be filled by 2025 with 20 new sites in the pipeline. A range of roles are likely to be available as the expansion of existing studios takes place, with a 'severe skills shortage' of set designers, bookkeepers, special effects experts, grips and assistant directors urgently required.



[Jobs for Ukrainian refugees](#)

Asda are offering 1,500 jobs to Ukrainian refugees. Applicants will be guaranteed an interview as long as they have the appropriate qualifications for the jobs advertised. A number of [other companies](#), including Marks and Spencer, are also pledging their support.

[Four-day week trial](#)

Around 30 organisations across the UK are piloting a four-day week as part of a UK wide pilot programme. The firms taking part include Girling Jones in Exeter, 5 Squirrels in Hove, and Pressure Drop Brewing and Happy in London.

[Universal credit claimants full-time study option extended](#)

The amount of time that universal credit claimants can study full time on work-related courses whilst still receiving benefits is currently 16 weeks. The ESFA have announced this option is to be extended until 28th April next year, i.e. up to 16 weeks can now be spent in work-related learning if the person is in the 'intensive work search group' for universal credit. As of January 2022 5.6 million people were receiving universal credit across the UK.

BOURNEMOUTH DORSET AND POOLE

[Weymouth and Portland lead the way on business growth within the county](#)

The Dorset Echo reports on job growth in Dorset during the pandemic. Weymouth and Portland in particular have seen an increase in the number of businesses with 8.5 per cent more businesses at the end of last year than at the start of 2020 according to research. Overall Dorset saw an increase of 3.1 per cent over the same period. Poole is the only area to have seen fewer active businesses.

[A new Health Technology Innovation Hub for Plymouth](#)

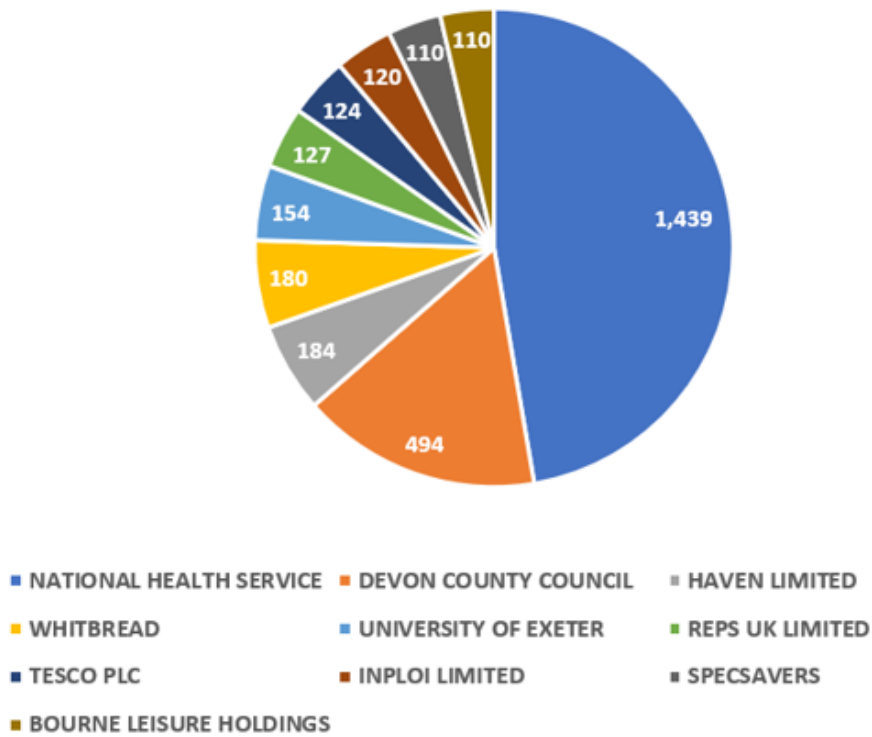
Heart of the South West LEP have supported a bid by Plymouth Science Park for a regional Health Technology Innovation Hub (HTIH) which will support health technology businesses and promote new technologies in the sector. It is expected to create over 100 jobs.

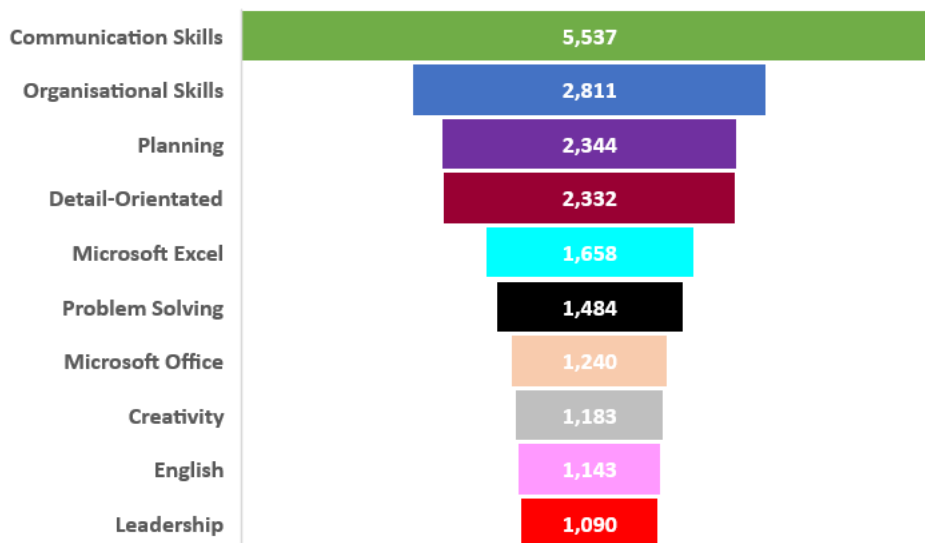


These employers had the most vacancies online:
