STATEMENT OF INTENT

Learning a foreign language is a liberation from insularity and provides an opening to other cultures, allowing students to become citizens of the world, thus equipping them to study and work in other countries. Our aim is to create engaged, inquisitive and confident linguists that can communicate effectively in real-life situations but also have a solid foundation of grammar that will open the door to studying languages at KS5. GCSE language learning will be cumulative and progressive in content and language, interleaving and building on the foundation of core grammar and vocabulary skills and processes learnt in KS3, increasing the level of linguistic and cognitive demand. Encouraging our students to identify with languages and valuing different styles of communication will help them develop a mindset that prizes academic progress too. Studies have shown that pupils who think themselves as good at languages outperform their peers not only in MFL, but also in other subjects.

IMPLEMENTATION

MFL teaching and learning at St Paul's enables pupils to express their ideas and thoughts in another language and to understand and respond to its speakers, both in speech and in writing. It should also provide opportunities for them to communicate for practical purposes, learn new ways of thinking and enjoy great literature and film in the original language. We highly encourage the study of Community Languages at GCSE level, including Polish, Portuguese, Italian, Greek, Russian, Arabic and Mandarin. The content, contexts and purposes of the course will provide an appropriate foundation for A Level study and a suitable preparation for higher education or employment.

Context and purposes

- GCSE specifications will require students to understand and use language across a range of contexts, appropriate to their age, interests and maturity levels. This also links to our school's PHSE/ RSHE programme, particularly with regards to the topics of careers and healthy living
- students will be expected to understand different types of spoken language, including recorded input from one or more speakers in public and social settings and recorded material from authentic sources and the media, appropriate to this level
- students will be expected to understand different types of written language, including relevant personal communication, public information, factual and literary texts, appropriate to this level
 - language contexts will be organised in a specified number of broad themes, addressing relevant matters relating to:
 - identity and culture
 - o local, national, international and global areas of interest
 - o current and future study and employment
 - the aforementioned topics link to other subjects, including geography and history (cultural lessons), health and social (healthy living), drama (role-plays on a variety of topics), media studies (film study), and English language (grammar)
